

# Touchwood too

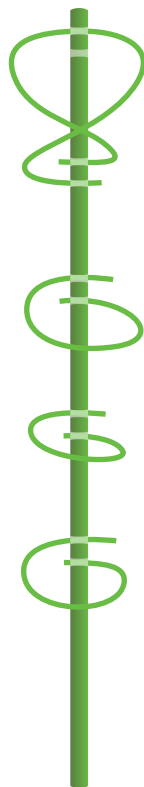
## Orchid & Plant Supports



### Assembly instructions:

Your kit consists of 6 stems and a length of cane to create the Orchid stem support loops or designs sufficient to create 2 Orchid and Plant Supports:

- 01 To create the best effect from the cane, remove from the packet and lay the cane out to allow the cane to relax prior to assembly
- 02 Decide how many stems you need to ensure the orchid / plant support stems have sufficient height to enable you to add the top swirl
- 03 Push the stems firmly together. Should you experience any difficulties pushing the stems together just wet the ends of the stems and then push them firmly together
- 04 Take the length of cane and cut 2 lengths 50cm long (scissors can be used to cut the cane)
- 05 With the 50cm lengths of cane create the top swirls by lightly marking the centre of the length of cane, push the cane through the single hole at the top of the stem
- 06 Pull the cane through the top single hole & locate the centre mark on the cane within the top hole of the stem
- 07 Take the cane & without kinking the cane pull the cane round the stem to locate the cane on the opposite side and into the next hole down the stem
- 08 Take the other end of the cane and complete the swirl by repeating the process leaving at least 1cm of cane protruding through the stem on each side
- 09 Now repeat steps 5 to 8 on the 2nd Orchid and Plant Support
- 10 Your Touchwood too plant support should now be tall enough that when pushed firmly into the Plant pot / soil the top swirl is above the height of the orchids flower
- 10 Insert the stem into the plant pot and select the remaining length of cane. Cut a short length sufficiently long enough to create a loop to retain the orchid stem to the Plant Support Stem using each pair of holes to create the loop as shown in the diagram
- 11 Continue to add or change the loops to provide the ideal support for your orchid or create your own designs from the cane to support your orchids and plants with a touch of style
